**SHOW HOURS:** Check-in is Friday 1-2 PM & Saturday 8-8:30 AM. Show hours for exhibitors are 2:30 PM – Done (Friday), 9 AM – Done (Saturday & Sunday).

**RECOMMENDED HOTEL:** None. DAYS INN COLUMBUS FAIRGROUNDS (1/2 mile from the show hall) 1700 Clara St, Columbus, OH 43211 (614) 299-4300 No group rate here, but this is the closer hotel. There is no official show hotel, but many in the area of the airport (CMH) and Expo.

**PAYMENT:** You can Paypal your entry fees to the club at [richsonrex@earthlink.net](mailto:richsonrex@earthlink.net) or send a check, payable to Showcats c/o Liz Brown 4899 Squaw Valley Drive Caledonia, IL 61011 or pay cash at the door at check-in. \*Early Bird rates honored ONLY if payment, in full, is done by February 1, 2024. Regular rates honored ONLY if payment, in full, is done by March 1. Tardy Turtle rates apply for those paying between March 2-6 and check-in. \$20 additional fee if you pay after March 6. \$25 additional fee beyond that if the club has to reach out to you after the show for payment.

**CATALOGS:** The club will be sending electronic catalogs out on Thursday, March 7, to all exhibitors. If you would like a hard copy catalog, you must request/pay for it on the summary sheet with your entry. \$10/catalog. Electronic catalogs will be sent without reservation. We will NOT have extra hard copy catalogs for sale at the show.

**THIS IS A BRING YOUR OWN BENCHING CAGE SHOW.** There will be no benching cages available.

**HEALTH.** This is a Non-Vetted show. All entries are to be free from contagious disease, and ALL Vaccinations must be up to date. Any entry showing signs of contagious illness, parasites, fungus or cats from homes exhibiting any signs of infectious or contagious disease in the prior 21 days are ineligible for entry or competition. Cats which are pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. Cats may NOT be kept in the show hall overnight. All HHP's eight (8) months of age or older MUST be altered. All claws must be clipped prior to judging.

**SUPPLIES:** Litter will be provided in show hall. Bring your own benching cage, cat food, litter pans, food/water bowls.

**CLERKS:** Please contact the entry clerk if you are available. Do not deduct your clerking fees from your entries. Clerks will be paid \$35.00 per day plus lunch.

**SHOW RULES:** This show is licensed and scored by TICA (The International Cat Association) and is subject to their show rules and breed standards. All exhibitors agree by entering to abide by the decisions of the show management and judges. A copy of all show rules is available from the TICA executive office, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, Texas 78551 or online at No kittens 3 months of age or younger will be permitted in the show hall. Proof of age and TICA litter registration must be available. Declawed cats are only allowed for entry pursuant to TICA Show Rule 23.5 (allowed for household pet or household pet kitten entries or if proof is submitted with entry that the declawing occurred prior to May 1, 2020, and that same cat was shown prior to the rule change on May 1, 2020). No vending from your benching area will be allowed. TICA Show rules will be strictly enforced.

**REGISTRATION:** Registration: Except for cats competing in the Preliminary New Breed, Advanced New Breed, and New Traits classes, registration with TICA is not required to compete. However, to be scored for TICA titles and Regional/International awards, all cats except HHP kittens must be registered by their second show.

**AWARDS:** Awards will be awarded in accordance with TICA Show Rules. This show is scored for TICA Regional and International awards.

**LIABILITY:** Showcats:Columbus, its individual members, the All American Columbus Pet Expo, Showcats Columbus or TICA will not be held liable for any loss or accident to spectators, exhibitors, cats or personal property.
